



#### St. Louis Family Theatre Series

Celebrating its 28th year in the community, this program introduces more than 20,000 St. Louis area school children and their families to live theatre annually. Over the years, the St. Louis Family Theatre Series' (SLFTS) performances have entertained almost a half million young people. The SLFTS began in 1986 as a Junior League of St. Louis priority group, then called "Audience of the Arts."


JLSL members working with SLFTS have several unique training opportunities, including serving as a docent in the classroom or as an usher at the theatre. Many local schools plan field trips to see performances each year. In preparation for the "theatre experience," a



# **Issue Based Community Impact**

In 2014, Junior League of St. Louis began the process of evaluating our community programs and aimed to implement Issue-based community impact (IBCI). Issue-based community impact is a way to shape an organization's civic engagement and helps identify what the League's role and positioning in the community will be. IBCI results in bigger, deeper, longer-term and more enduring works than a traditional Junior League's project-based efforts. JLSL's Board of Governance also formed a committee called the Community Programs Board Committee to help implement IBCI principles.

JLSL members attended panel discussions and a town hall meeting to learn more about three issues identified by the Community Programs Board Committee: infant mortality, financial capability and women's issues. At the March General Membership Meetings, JLSL members selected infant mortality as the issue it will wrap itself around through May 31, 2021.
