COMMUNITY IMPACT

Junior League of St. Louis provided more than 100 Community Impact volunteer opportunities throughout the year to our trained volunteers to support organizations within our community.



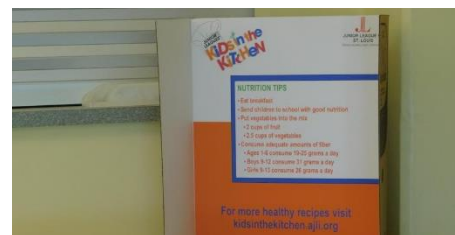
In 2016, Junior League of St. Louis launched **Day 366**, an initiative aimed at dramatically reducing

infant mortality in St. Louis region. To help St. Louis babies stay healthy, *we collected more than 70,000 items including diapers, wipes, rash cream, and bottles that were then distributed to St. Louis-area moms via our community partners.*



Partnering with Affinia Healthcare and Grace Hill, we hosted *the 9th edition of our keystone community event, Strong Women & Families Health & Resource Fair on August 11, 2018*. We served more than 450 families and provided them with information and on-site resources in the areas of finance, education, employment, housing, legal services, healthcare, and wellness in a fun, family-friendly, low-stress environment.

Kids in the Kitchen was included in our 9th Annual Strong Women & Families Health & Resource Fair for the first time in August 2018. KITK is a national program established by the Association of Junior Leagues International to empower youth to make healthy lifestyle choices and help reverse the growth of childhood obesity and its associated health issues.



The *League Larks & Nightingales* choral groups also provided live music therapy to nursing home residents, retirement centers, adult day care and rehabilitation facilities throughout the St. Louis area.
